A paleontological whodunit, set 150 million years ago in the late Jurassic period, at a place that would later be part of Germany, this second volume in the Dinosaur series investigates the suspicious death of an Archaeopteryx, telling the tale in graphic novel form. Following the story, the book describes what science has discovered about this early type of bird and the world it lived in, and discusses its importance as a transitional species between birds and dinosaurs. Like the other books in the series a collaboration between a talented artist and a noted paleontologist re-creates the vanished world of the dinosaurs for readers 9 to 13, first in a comic depicting an individual living in its geological time and place, then in a detailed scientific account of the real-life animal's behavior and its interactions with other species. Here too are several short essays, illustrated with drawings and photos, that explain more about the various creatures and geographical settings encountered in the story. 62.
